If you choose to stay in a hotel on South Bass Island, your registration fee will be \$200 and \$250 (before and after 12 September) and you will be responsible for paying your hotel bill.

Accommodations: All meetings and meals will be at Stone Laboratory on Gibraltar Island (www.sg.ohio-state.edu) in the harbor at Put-in-Bay, Ohio. The village of Put-in-Bay is on South Bass Island. By visiting our web site and progressing to Stone Laboratory, Directions and Maps, About Us, and Island Campus, you will find directions and see an aerial photo of Gibraltar Island (http://www.sg.ohio-state.edu/slab/about/campus.asp). I can accommodate up to about 40 on Gibraltar Island in either single or double occupancy rooms (no cost difference). We will accommodate as many as possible in single rooms and then go to double occupancy. Those not wishing to stay in University housing, or wishing to guarantee a single room, can book their own hotel rooms in Put-in-Bay. I suggest the Islander Inn at 1-877-500-7829. They have given us a rate for this Stone Laboratory affiliated group of \$90/night. It is very easy to stay in this hotel and take the water taxi (5 minutes) to and from meetings on Gibraltar Island. Please call if you would like to come a day early.

Travel:

Cleveland Hopkins International Airport is suggested, but Detroit Metro and Toledo will also work. It is about a 1.5-2 hour drive from Cleveland to the Miller Ferry Boat that services Put-in-Bay. We will provide a van and make one round trip leaving Cleveland Hopkins International Airport at 11:00 AM on the 21st and returning at 3:00 on the 23rd for those not wishing to rent cars. For those renting cars, I suggest that you leave them in parking lots on the mainland and not bring them over to South Bass Island on the ferryboat. Miller Ferry from Catawba Point (http://www.millerferry.com/) costs \$11.00 for a roundtrip fare (not

included in your registration fee). You can also come on the Jet Express Ferry (\$22.00 roundtrip) from Port Clinton, Ohio, if you choose (http://www.jet-express.com/PortClinton.html).
